This communiqué highlights key discussions from the Health Support Services (HSS) Board meeting held on 2 December 2021.

Key Discussion

The Minister for Health 'Your Voice in Health' Employee Engagement Action Plan was approved by the HSS Board. On behalf of the Board, I would like to thank the Workforce and Organisational Development team for the time and effort and quality of action plan produced.

Chief Executive's Update

The HSS Strategic Plan 2022-2024 launch events have commenced. The Plan was internally launched on 3rd November 2021 at HSS, attended by the HSS Board Chair, Board members and HSS staff. The Plan will be officially launched with our customers and key stakeholders at an event on 15th December 2021, to be attended by the Minister for Health, Director General, Health Chief Executives, and other key customer stakeholders and contributor through the strategic plan development process.

The Office of the Auditor General (OAG) has completed a performance audit of the WA COVID-19 Vaccine Rollout program. The report was tabled in Parliament on Thursday 18th November 2021. The OAG has made two recommendations that the Department of Health will action.

The Human Resource Management Information System Program (HRMIS) Program continues to progress well. The Program has submitted a business case to deliver the new HRMIS that is being considered by the Office of Digital Government and the Department of Treasury in line with the Digital Capability Fund and Mid-Year Review State Budget process.

The Medical Imaging Replacement Program (MIRP) has negotiated a new timeline for production readiness with the vendor and commissioning at hospital sites have commenced. It is expected the last hospital to go-live with the new imaging system will be in late August 2022 and the entire commissioning process is expected to be completed by mid to late September 2022.

The HealthNext Program's Transition phase is complete, and project close-out activities are nearing completion. The Transformation phase continues to make good progress, with two service definitions being endorsed during the month and significant progress made towards development of the eReferrals application blueprint. The transformation phase is on track to be completed by 31st December 2021.

Work is progressing well for a new contemporary telephony solution at HSS. An approach has been established to deliver phase 1 by mid-December 2021, which will enable all HSS employees to work virtually.
